What Awaits You

Prepare for an authentic and unfiltered expedition - this is not your typical luxury travel. While it may present challenges, it will undoubtedly be immensely rewarding and life-changing.

During this journey, we will forge connections with both the inhabitants and the amphibians of the jungle. Our visit will bring valuable resources, support, and genuine connections to the villages. Such interactions significantly benefit the tribes, equipping them to sustain their livelihoods while safeguarding the rainforest and its precious frog inhabitants.



What's Included

- Hotel and accommodation from Oct 22 - Oct 29.
- All meals while staying with the Matses. Free breakfast is provided at the hotel, but all meals in Iquitos will be your responsibility.
- Your transportation to/from the airport to the Epoca hotel in Iquitos.
- Mosquito nets.
- All transportation to and from village and other group activities.
- Kambo rituals.
- All teachings, lessons, and activities described.

What's Not Included

- Your airfare to and from Iquitos.
- Rubber Boots.
- Hammock or sleeping camp pad.
- Your food while in Iquitos (except for hotel breakfast included).
- Independent taxi rides around Iquitos.
- Souvenirs or gifts that you purchase.
- Kambo/Nunu/Sananga supplies that you may purchase.

Schedule

October 22, Tuesday:

Meet in Iquitos at Epoca hotel by 3 pm, Eat dinner together at Dawn of the Amazon at 6 pm for introductions.

October 23, Wednesday:

One Day in Iquitos to ground, decompress, and shop. Breakfast together, Art Market, Belen Market for all your favorite items. At Belen market we will get rubber boots and hammocks for those who need them. Free time to explore and rest before our journey into the jungle. There's also a monkey preserve for those that want to go. We can leave items locked up at the hotel while visiting the Matses.

October 24, Thursday:

Hike to Ibama Matses village, Relax.

October 25, Friday - October 27, Sunday:

Matses village stay.

October 28, Monday:

Hike out of village & return to Iquitos, Dinner/Integration, Sleep at Epoca Hotel.

October 29, Tuesday:

Official trip itinerary ends.

Getting to Iquitos and Back

Currently, there are no COVID restrictions to fly into Peru. You are not required to show proof of vaccination or negative PCR. Be sure to stay updated on the requirements to enter Peru.

Your adventure in the Amazon Rainforest requires a well-packed bag. Here are some suggestions on what to bring:

Essential Documents

- Passport.

Travel Comfort

- Neck pillow.
- Money belt/fanny pack.

Clothing

- Lightweight raincoat.
- Quick dry pants.
- 4-5 pairs of underwear.
- 2 pairs of shorts.
- 2 tank tops.
- 2 long sleeve linen shirts.
- 1 linen jumpsuit.
- 1 long sleeve cotton/poly shirt.
- 4 pairs of tall socks.
- Sweater (nights can get chilly).
- Swim suit.
- Rash guard.

Footwear

- Hiking shoes.
- Flip flops.
- Optional: Shoes for walking in town.

Sleeping Gear

- Hammock/camping pad.
- Mosquito net.
- Straps for hammock.
- Sheet/lightweight blanket.

Ideas for Hammock

If you prefer a hammock to a camping pad, consider the following options, which are similar to what I borrowed from a friend.

These hammocks allow you to lay at an angle for a flatter sleeping surface.

Health and Hygiene

- Sunscreen.

- Charcoal/slippery elm.
- Imodium.
- Probiotics.
- Ibuprofen.
- Ginger.
- Peroxide.
- ChiggerX cream with 10% lidocaine.
- Mosquito cream.
- Dragon's blood.
- Band-aids, gauze (for blisters, cuts).
- Pads/tampons.
- Quart zip lock for garbage.
- Water bottle.
- Water filter/ life straw.
- Bug spray.
- Eye mask.
- Ear plugs.
- Chapstick.

- Water wipes/baby wipes.
- Alcohol wipes.
- Eye drops.
- Sunglasses.
- Mirror.
- Tweezers.

Electronics

- Headlamp.
- Phone battery charger.
- Phone charger (hotel uses U.S. plugs).

Personal Care

- Hairbrush.
- Toothbrush.
- Toothpaste.
- Dr. Bronner's soap.

Snacks

- Your favorite lightweight, non-perishable snacks.
